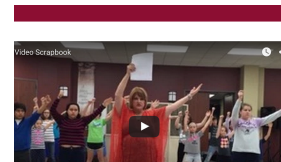

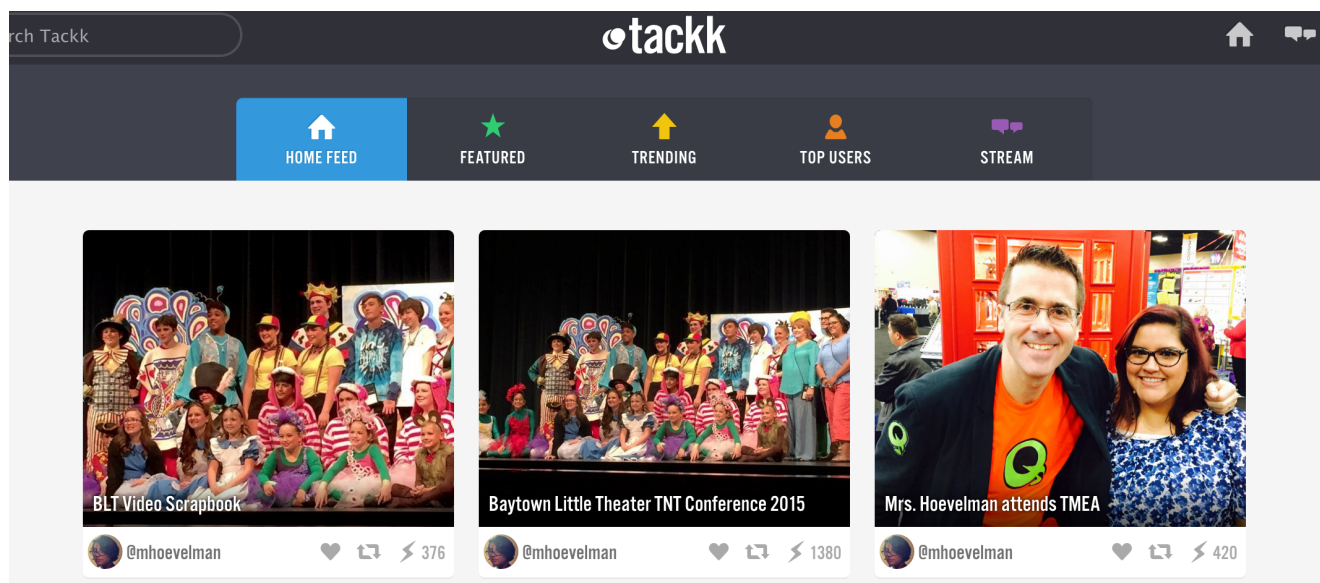

Tackks allow teachers to share information easily. They can be used in many different ways:

- Specialized Lessons
- Parent or Faculty Newsletters/Calendars
- Presentations
- links to studies on the efficacy of music education
- Celebrating individual students successes if they were awarded something outside of school
- Links to a GoFundMe page to fundraise for new equipment
- Playlists of past YouTube performances
- Playlists of YouTube videos that you love...classical music, children's choir, youth orchestras, etc.

FAQs

- **How do I add more content to my Tackk?**
 - On the bottom of your Tackk, click any icon in your widget bar to add content. You can also add content by hovering over the area where you want to add and clicking the icon within the Tackk.
- **How do I add a link to my Tackk?**
 - Highlight text you'd like to link to reveal the options editor. Click the link icon, choose Insert link, paste your URL in the prompt and click Insert.
- **How do I style my text?**
 - To bold or italicize your text, highlight the desired text to reveal the style options editor and then press the b or i button. To add bullet points or a numbered list, highlight the desired text and select either the bulleted or numbered list option from the style options editor.

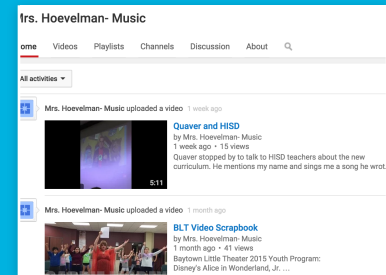

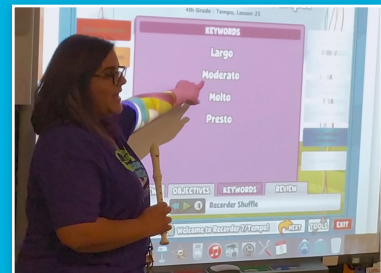
